PRINCIPLE

• The group is divided into **teams of 5 to 8 students**. Each team will receive a **road book** that provides **historical information**, the **itinerary** to follow, and **questions**, as well as an **answer sheet** in the form of a multiple-choice questionnaire.

EDUCATIONAL VALUE

- Discovery of local heritage: exploration of the topics mentioned above to expand students' knowledge
- Development of observational skills: active visual research by students to find the answers
- Spatial orientation: following a well-defined route to strengthen observational abilities
- Team spirit: only one roadbook per team to promote collaboration

GAME PROCESS

• Welcome of the group and explanation of the game rules by our experienced supervisor

- Formation of teams, supervised by your chaperones
- Distribution of roadbooks and answer sheets
- Remote support via phone during the activity
- Collection and correction of answer sheets upon arrival
- Distribution of gingerbread cookies to students and chaperones
