# The old Strasbourg



Discover the 3 emblematic districts of the historic centre of Strasbourg thanks to a treasure hunt: Strasbourg Cathedral: half-timbered houses of craftsmen and private mansions from the 16th century / Gutenberg: place of economic activity of the medieval city: tribes of merchants and river customs / La Petite France: traditional half-timbered houses of tanners

### PRINCIPLE

A roadbook contains historical information, the itinerary, questions and a sheet to answer the questions in the form of MCQs


### STRONG POINTS

- Discovery of the local heritage : buildings and monuments
- Development of the sense of observation : search for the answers to the questions
- Finding your bearings in space : itinerary to follow
- Group spirit : only one logbook per team of 5 to 8 members

### GAME PROCESS

- Welcome of the group by our experienced leader
- Explanation of the rules of the game
- Constitution of the teams
- Distribution of roadbook and answer sheets
- Telephone assistance during the game in autonomy
- Correction of the answer sheets on arrival
- Distribution of gingerbread to participants and a bottle of Alsace wine for the winning team
