### TOPICS DISCUSSED

Chronology of the cathedral construction – Craftsmen emblems (sculptors, architects) – Architectural styles (Palais Rohan, Maison Kammerzell) – Famous figures (Gustave Doré, Alphonse Laveran)

### PRINCIPLE

A **roadbook** contains **historical information**, the **itinerary**, the **questions** and a form to answer the questions in the form of MCQs



### EDUCATIONAL VALUE

- Discovery of the local heritage: history of the most important buildings
- Development of the sense of observation: search for answers to the questions
- Finding your bearings in space: itinerary to follow
- Group spirit: one roadbook per team of 5 to 8 members

### GAME PROCESS

- Welcome of the group by our **experienced animator**
- Explanation of the rules of the game
- Constitution of the teams supervised by your guides
- Distribution of the roadbooks and answer sheets
- Telephone assistance during the game in autonomy
- Correction of the answer sheets on arrival
- Distribution of **gingerbread** to participants and accompanying persons
