### TOPICS COVERED DURING THE TREASURE HUNT

The Reformation – The Free City of the Holy Roman Empire of the German Nation – The capitulation of Strasbourg under Louis XIV – The city's defensive system – The origin of street names – The importance of guilds – The principle of leather tanning

### PRINCIPLE

The **group** is divided into **teams**, with each team receiving a **roadbook** that includes **historical information**, the **route** to follow, questions, and a form presented as a **multiple-choice questionnaire (MCQ)**.

### EDUCATIONAL VALUE

- **Discovery of local heritage:** Exploration of the aforementioned themes to deepen participants' knowledge
- **Development of observational skills:** Students actively engage in finding answers to the questions
- **Spatial orientation:** Following a clearly defined route to enhance observational ability
- **Team spirit:** Each team of 5 to 8 participants uses a single roadbook, promoting collaboration

### GAME PROCESS

- Reception of the group by our experienced facilitator
- Presentation of the game rules
- Formation of teams, supervised by your guides
- Distribution of roadbooks and answer sheets
- Telephone support during the game on a self-directed basis
- Correction of answer sheets upon arrival
- Distribution of gingerbread to participants and guides
