









# TOPICS COVERED DURING THE RALLY

Visual discovery of the buildings in the European Quarter – The functioning of institutions such as the Council of Europe, the European Parliament, and the European Court of Human Rights – Presentation of the rotation of the presidency of the institutions through the artworks donated by member countries – as well as the names of great political figures who contributed to the creation of Europe









# PRINCIPLE

The **group** is divided into **teams**, with each team receiving a **roadbook** that includes **historical information**, the **route** to follow, **questions**, and a form presented as a **multiple-choice questionnaire (MCQ)**.







# EDUCATIONAL VALUE



- **Discovery of local heritage:** Exploration of the aforementioned themes to deepen participants’ knowledge
- **Development of observational skills:** Students actively engage in finding answers to the questions
- **Spatial orientation:** Following a clearly defined route to enhance observational ability
- **Team spirit:** Each team of 5 to 8 participants uses a single roadbook, promoting collaboration









# GAME PROCESS



- Reception of the group by our experienced facilitator
- Presentation of the game rules
- Formation of teams, supervised by your guides
- Distribution of roadbooks and answer sheets
- Telephone support during the game on a self-directed basis
- Correction of answer sheets upon arrival
- Distribution of gingerbread to participants and guides
